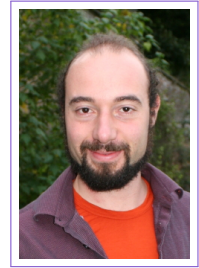

The research applies psychophysical methods of measuring eye movements to assess time perception in well participants given ketamine as a dissociative agent and in patients with bipolar disorder.
